As you know, National Day for Truth and Reconciliation (NDTR) occurs on September 30. In the past, with the generous support of our partners and sponsors like yourself, we have been able to offer inclusive events and activities held at various locations within the Lakeland area. With this in mind, we humbly ask for your continued financial support for this year's activities, as we bring awareness and understanding that the NDTR Commemoration commands.

Last year's NDTR commemorative activities were so well received that we would like to make them available again this year. However, one of our key partners (Heritage Canada) had a reduction in their program budget, which meant that our approved grant amount was also reduced. We realize that we must live within our means. Blanket Workshop: Connects Indigenous and non-Indigenous individuals by creating a safe place for conversation, sharing, and learning about what it means to build allyships. Traditional lunch included.

<u>Shirts'n Skirts</u>: Create your own ribbon skirt or ribbon vest. Learn valuable teachings. Workshop includes all supplies.

Former Blue Quills Residential School Tour: Guided by a Blue Quills Residential School Survivor.

<u>Drive Through Town Procession</u>: In partnership with the Town of Bonnyville, on the eve of NDTR, aimed to bring a conscious awareness of the children that suffered in Indian Residential Schools, led with either an RCMP officer or Town Bylaw officer, vehicles drive through a planned route in the streets of Bonnyville for an hour, while playing traditional music on a tailgate speaker.

<u>Orange Shirt Walk</u>: In partnership with the Town of Bonnyville, participants will walk down Main Street Bonnyville to bring attention to the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation. Start and end location to be determined.

<u>September 30 Commemoration</u>: Tipi raising, pipe ceremony, visual displays of former Blue Quills Residential School, local survivor stories, Artisans, traditional meal, followed by a blend of First Nations and Métis speakers, musicians, dancers, and storytellers.

Throughout the day's activities, we will provide onsite a registered Indigenous mental health therapist that is specialized in trauma, for anyone attending who is in need of support.

Our mission is always to honour the children who survived Indian Residential Schools and to remember those who didn't. #EveryChildMatters Therefore, it is imperative that all of our events are accessible for all people and free of charge:)
