On behalf of the Board of Directors of the Bonnyville & District Historical Society, I wish to make a formal request for a continued Operating Grant for the years 2025, 2026, and 2027. Annually, the Town of Bonnyville has generously provided the organization with \$30,000. The grant directly assists us with the expenses of providing services and programming to the community and visitors through the Bonnyville & District Museum. For 2025, due to exorbitant operating costs and aging buildings needing upkeep, we would like to request \$35,000. With this increase, we would be agreeable and enthusiastic about working with the Town of Bonnyville on joint ventures, projects, partnerships, personnel sharing, etc.

We have so greatly appreciated your financial support for the past years. Without your financial contribution we most certainly would have faced immense challenges in personnel and operational expenses. Over the last decade we have made tremendous strides in expanding our programming, facility and exhibits, and our organization continues to show unwavering commitment and dedication to representing the historic and cultural foundation of the region, as well as fundraising efforts, revenue generation, and facility maintenance and enhancement.

We face tremendous challenges with increasing overhead costs as well as maintenance on aging buildings and infrastructure. We know that our most sustainable way forward is with a full-time manager, and we are diligently working to find a person who is both qualified and able to work within our tight budgetary constraints. This is more difficult than you might imagine. We have many fantastic ideas to further broaden the community and cultural reach of the organization; we must always work to balance our plans and projects with our fiscal prudence.

Thank you for your consideration of this request as you develop your budget(s) for the coming years. Please know that your assistance has assisted us fulfilling the important role that the Bonnyville & District Historical Society and Museum plays in preserving and interpreting the history and culture of all the peoples of the Bonnyville region.
