#### Domestic Violence impact:

A 2009 study estimates the cost of dealing with the aftermath of domestic violence at 7.4 billion dollars in Canada. These costs include things like healthcare expenses, legal fees, lost productivity, and social services.

#### Prevention Education:


Direct services in Bonnyville, reducing intimate partner violence
