**SUBJECT: Bylaw No. 1587-25 The Water and Sewer Bylaw**

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**BACKGROUND:** At the January 28<sup>th</sup> Regular meeting of Council, the Draft Water and Sewer Bylaw received first reading. The Water and Sewer Bylaw is being updated to improve service delivery and communication with residents.

**OTHER COMMENTS:** The Water and Sewer Bylaw No. 1393-12 was last adopted in 2012 and is due for updating to reflect current practices, new vocabulary, to reference current legislation and to increase fine amounts for contravention of the Bylaw.

Recommended changes from a legal review have been included in this draft of the Bylaw and are highlighted in “blue” in the Memorandum of updates. Changes are focused to section 14, “Enforcement and Penalties” and Schedule “D” release of legal liability on water bypasses.
